The Council publishes Standards and Rules of Procedure for Approval of Law Schools (Standards). The Council also regularly reviews and updates the Standards and issues interpretations to assist law schools in conforming to the standards. Law schools are visited every seven years by a team including representatives of the ABA and also the American Association of Law Schools (AALS) to insure the schools are still in sufficient compliance with the Standards to merit reaccreditation.<sup>2</sup>
