In *BYK Mb_ H_a Yg* bestseller *HA Y'8J JXY. '5a YrMb :b1 gJW'b* *AY5[YcZH YK YUH ; UH* Matt Taibbi takes readers on a

galvanizing journey through both sides of our new system of justice: the untouchably wealthy and the criminalized poor. As he narrates these incredible stories, he draws out and analyzes their common source, and unveils what we need to do to stand up against the troubling trend of the Divide.

Taibbi is also the author of *fJAdU* one of the most entertainingly quotable, scathing, and illuminating histories of the economic crisis. In 2008, he won the National Magazine Award for his columns in *Fc`Jp['GcbY'* (where he was a contributing editor). He was recently sought out by First Look Media to launch a digital magabor

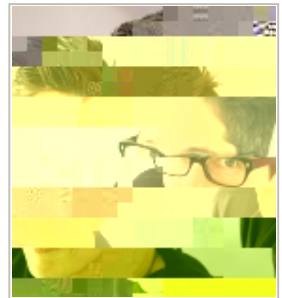
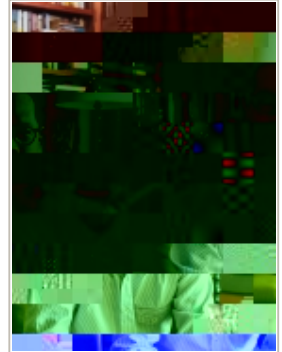
